- The Horse of the Year Award
- Peter O'Sullevan Partnership of the Year Award

The awards also include presentations of the **RoR Elite Series winners** across seven equestrian disciplines.





Ror REACH AND MEDIA COVERAGE

RoR has more than **19,000 members** and over 15,000 registered former racehorses.

In 2025, the RoR Awards generated **73 pieces** of media coverage, including ITV and BBC.

The total TV audience exceeded 2.2 million.
